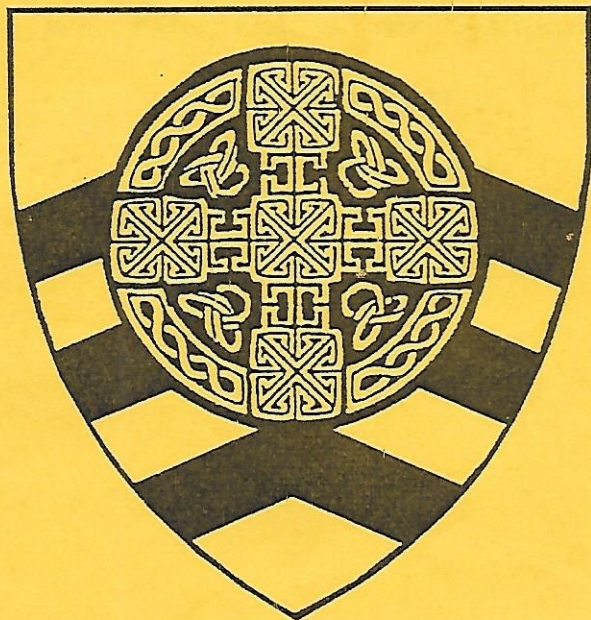

- INT.1 Wall tablet. Bronze. Condition good. Inscription good. South facing.  
The path of duty/was the way to glory/in honoured memory/of one who served/his King & Country/in the/Great European War/PTE. REGINALD SHEPPARD./The Welsh Regiment./Beloved son of Mr. & Mrs. Sheppard. Llanharan/died of wounds June 11 1916/interred Bethune, France/aged 20 years.
- INT.2 Carved on base of prayer desk. Wood. Condition good. Inscription good. North facing.  
In memory of FLOSSIE ALMA PAYNE:who died 11th Mar 1947.
- INT.3 Window (East). Stained glass. Condition good. Inscription good, and facing West.  
In memory of RICHARD HOARE JENKINS, Esq/died April 24th 1856 aged 78/this window is erected by his remaining sister/ANNE POYNTZ. the wife of the Rev'd H. POYNTZ.
- INT.4 Wall tablet. Marble. Condition good. Inscription good. Facing North.  
Sacred to the memory of WILLIAM GIBBON of Trecastle, Newton/House in this county, Esq'r, who departed. this life the 21st day of/February 1810 in the 50th year of his age/2 line verse./ To perpetuate his memory and many virtues,/ this monument is/erected by his most affectionate widow ANN GIBBON/Underneath lies interred the remains of the above-named ANN GIBBON/who departed this life the 4th day of November in the year 1813 aged 55 years/she was the youngest daughter of the late SAMUEL PRICE of Park, Esqr./and sister of the late MARY LEWIS./widow of the Rev'd WILLIAM LEWIS M.A. of New-House/and sister of JOHN PRICE, of Llandough Castle, Esqr.
- INT.5 Headstone, against wall, behind choir stall on right hand side of church. Limestone. Condition very good. Inscription good, partially obscured by seat.  
Family Crest. SIDEUS. CONTRANOS. NOBISCUMQUIS.  
Within these rails lie bury'd./MORRIS MATTHEW of Meiros one of ye/younger sons, of ABERAMMAN/GENT, died Nov 12th 1683 aged 82./WILLIAM MATTHEW his son./ GENT,died Dec 5th 1713 aged 71/JOHN MATTHEW. son to the said WILLIAM MATTHEW died/Feb 8th 1764 aged 92



INT.6 Wall tablet - oval. Marble. Condition good.  
 Inscription good. Facing North.  
 Underneath lie interred/REES POWELL Esquire and ELIZABETH his wife, heiress of CREIGA IN CWM-NEDD/he died June 28th 1758 aged 79/she having died before him Jan'y 5th 1743 aged 63/also nine of their children viz: GERVAS, WILLIAM/MARY, JOHN, GERVAS, ALICE, JOANNA, REES and WILLIAM/who all died in celibacy-the last a councillor at law aged 52/This monument was erected to the memory of his/much and deservedly respected parents by their only surviving/son GERVAS POWELL CL.L.L.B. Prebendary of Llandaff. He being/ likewise the only male survivor of the very ancient families/of the POWELLS of Llwydarth and Maesteg in Llangonoyd/descended in a direct line from BINION AP CADIFOR AP COLLWYN(AP TANGNO/one of the fifteen tribes of North Wales)Prince of Dyfed by NEST/daughter of/ IESTYN AP GWRGANT, Lord of Glamorgan/a lady who was the unhappy, tho' innocent occasion of the/conquest of of this county by ROBERT FITZHAMMON in the year 1090/ also GERVAS, son of the above GERVAS by MARGARET his wife/eldest daughter of CHARLES VAUGHAN of SKETHROG in the county/of BRECON, Esquire, by REBECCA his wife sole daughter and heiress/of WILLIAM PRICE of KILMERRY, in the same county Esquire/by POSTHUMA, his wife, daughter of ROLAND GWYNNE of GLANBRAN/in the county of Carmarthen, Esquire by ANN his wife, daughter/of HUMPHREY WYNDHAM of Dunraven in this county, Esquire/he died July 10th 1772 aged one month./ also the above mentioned GERVAS POWELL, LLB PREBENDARY/of Llandaff, Rector of Merthyr and Llanfigan, the last male survivor/of the POWELLS of Llwydarth, died July 8th 1795 aged 72/the tender husband, affectionate father, sincere friend and/ indulgent master were truly combined in him./ Also the above named MARGARET POWELL/who died 1st. September 1798./aged 62 years.
